

CBA Grade Point Average (GPA) Policy

Freshmen Students - Students are considered freshmen students if they enter K-State and have not completed any college-level course work following high school graduation, with the exception of the summer following high school graduation.

Transfer Students – Students are considered transfer students if they enter K-State and have taken college-level course work following high school graduation. Students who have completed college-level work in high school or the summer following high school graduation are classified as entering freshmen students.

- Transfer students must have a **2.5 transfer GPA** to be admitted to the CBA.
- All transfer coursework approved by the K-State Admissions Office, with a **grade of C or better**, will be reviewed by the CBA Office of Student Services for equivalency within the business curriculum and is subject to final approval. (Transfer coursework carrying a grade of D will not be accepted toward a student's business degree requirements.)
- Transfer students entering with less than 45 credit hours:
 - Students must complete at least 12 credit hours at K-State and have a minimum of 45 total (transfer and K-State) credit hours completed with at least a 2.5 GPA in order to declare a major.
- Transfer students entering with more than 45 credit hours:
 - Students must complete at least 12 credit hours at K-State and have at least a 2.5 K-State GPA in order to declare a major.
 - Students must earn at least a 2.5 K-State GPA on their first 15 hours completed at K-State to declare a major or they will be dismissed from the CBA.

GPA Requirements to Enter Major (upon completion of 45-60 credit hours) and to Graduate:

- **Note: Transfer GPA will not be considered in determining eligibility to enter a major.** Only the K-State GPA is applicable. However, ALL hours (K-State and any transfer hours) are included in the 45-60 hours.
- **Following admission to their major, student must complete at least 9 credit hours of upper-level (300 and above) business credit hours at K-State to be eligible for graduation.**
- **Accounting:** 3.0 K-State cumulative GPA. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA in ALL ACCOUNTING COURSES, (ACCTG-###), including transfer courses, 2.5 GPA in all Business Core courses and a 2.0 K-State cumulative GPA in order to graduate.
- **Management Information Systems:** 2.5 K-State cumulative GPA and successful completion of Management 367 (earning a grade of C or better). Students will be allowed to enroll in upper-level MIS courses (MANGT 570, MANGT 576, MANGT 666, and MANGT 686) only if they have earned a grade of C or better for each prerequisite to those courses. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA in all Business Core courses and a 2.0 K-State cumulative GPA in order to graduate.
- **Entrepreneurship, Finance, General Business, General Management, Operations and Supply Chain Management, Human Resource Management and Marketing:** 2.5 KSU cumulative GPA to enter major and 2.5 GPA in all Business Core courses and 2.0 K-State cumulative GPA in order to graduate.

***Business core courses are defined as those carrying a prefix of ACCTG, GENBA, FINAN, MANGT, or MKTG.**
