GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) Policy

Freshmen Students - Students are considered freshmen students if they enter K-State and have not completed any college-level course work following high school graduation, with the exception of the summer following high school graduation.

Transfer Students – Students are considered transfer students if they enter K-State and have taken college-level course work following high school graduation. Students who have completing college-level work in high school or the summer following high school graduation are classified as entering freshmen students.

- Transfer students must have a 2.5 transfer GPA to be admitted to the CBA.
- Transfer students entering with less than 45 credit hours/units:
 - Students must complete at least 12 credit hours/units at K-State and have a minimum of 45 total (transfer and K-State) credit hours/units completed with at least a 2.5 GPA (3.0 GPA for accounting) in order to declare a major/plan.
- Transfer students entering with 45 or more credit hours/units:
 - Students must earn at least a 2.5 K-State GPA on their first 15 hours completed at K-State to declare a major/plan or they will be dismissed from the CBA.
 - Students must complete at least 12 credit hours/units at K-State and have at least a 2.5 K-State GPA in order to declare a major/plan.

GPA Requirements to Enter Major/Plan (upon completion of 45-60 credit hours/units):

- Students with 60 total credit hours/units **MUST** declare a major/plan. Otherwise the student must change out of the CBA.
- Transfer students with more than 60 hours/units must complete 12 credit hours/units at K-State before they can declare a major/plan.
- Transfer GPA will not be considered in determining eligibility to enter a major/plan. Only K-State credit hours/units and GPA are applicable.
- **Accounting:** 3.0 K-State cumulative GPA. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA in ALL ACCOUNTING COURSES (ACCTG-###) and a 2.0 K-State cumulative GPA in order to graduate.
- **Management Information Systems:** 2.5 K-State cumulative GPA and acceptance into program through application process. Students admitted into program will be allowed to enroll in MIS courses only if they have earned a grade of C or better for each prerequisite to those courses. Students must maintain a 2.0 K-State cumulative GPA in order to graduate.
- **Marketing, Finance, Organizational Management, Operations and Supply Chain Management, and Human Resource Management:** 2.5 KSU cumulative GPA. Students must maintain a 2.0 K-State cumulative GPA in order to graduate.

Requirements to Graduate

- Students must earn a minimum 2.5 grade point average in the business core courses to graduate.
