- Drove trucks, tractors and other equipment to distribute feed to animals.
- Inspected, maintained and repaired equipment, machinery, buildings, pens, yards and fences.
- Provided medical treatment, such as administering medications and vaccinations and arranged for veterinarians to provide more extensive treatment.
- Herded livestock to pastures for grazing or to scales, trucks, or other enclosures.
- Identified ownership and grade, using brands, tags, paint and tattoos.
- Moved equipment, poultry and livestock from one location to another, manually and using trucks and carts.
- Fed and watered livestock and monitored food and water supplies.
- Used disinfectant solutions, brushes, shovels, water hoses and pumps.
- Protected herds from predators like coyotes.
- Shifted animals between grazing areas for sufficient access to food.
- Sprayed livestock with disinfectants and insecticides, or dipped or bathed animals.
- Patrolled grazing lands on horseback or using all-terrain vehicles.
- Ordered food for animals, and arranged for delivery.
- Performed duties related to livestock reproduction, such as breeding animals within appropriate timeframes, performing artificial inseminations and helping with animal births.
- Castrated animals, tagged animals.
- Use PVC pipe for plumbing and electrical use. (using primer and glue)
- Help pour concrete for retaining walls and shop/garage floors
- Use air and power tools to set trusses and sheet roofs
