Supporting information: We award scholarships at the end of the spring semester to our student members on the basis of scholastic achievement, club involvement and project activities. Therefore, those who are most active in the club are the most likely to receive a scholarship; however, we require high academic achievement as well. We accept applications from members and provide them to our faculty advisor who will clear them of any personally identifiable data. Because club officers may also apply, our faculty advisor ensures that any officer who does apply does not review his or her own application. Candidates are then ranked by the officers without reference to other officers' decisions. Individually, each officer provides their rankings and comments to the faculty advisor. If additional rounds are necessary, the faculty advisor will contact the officers and the process will repeat. Ultimately, the names of the nominees are then sent to the College's Scholarship Committee, headed by Dr. Desai, for final approval.
